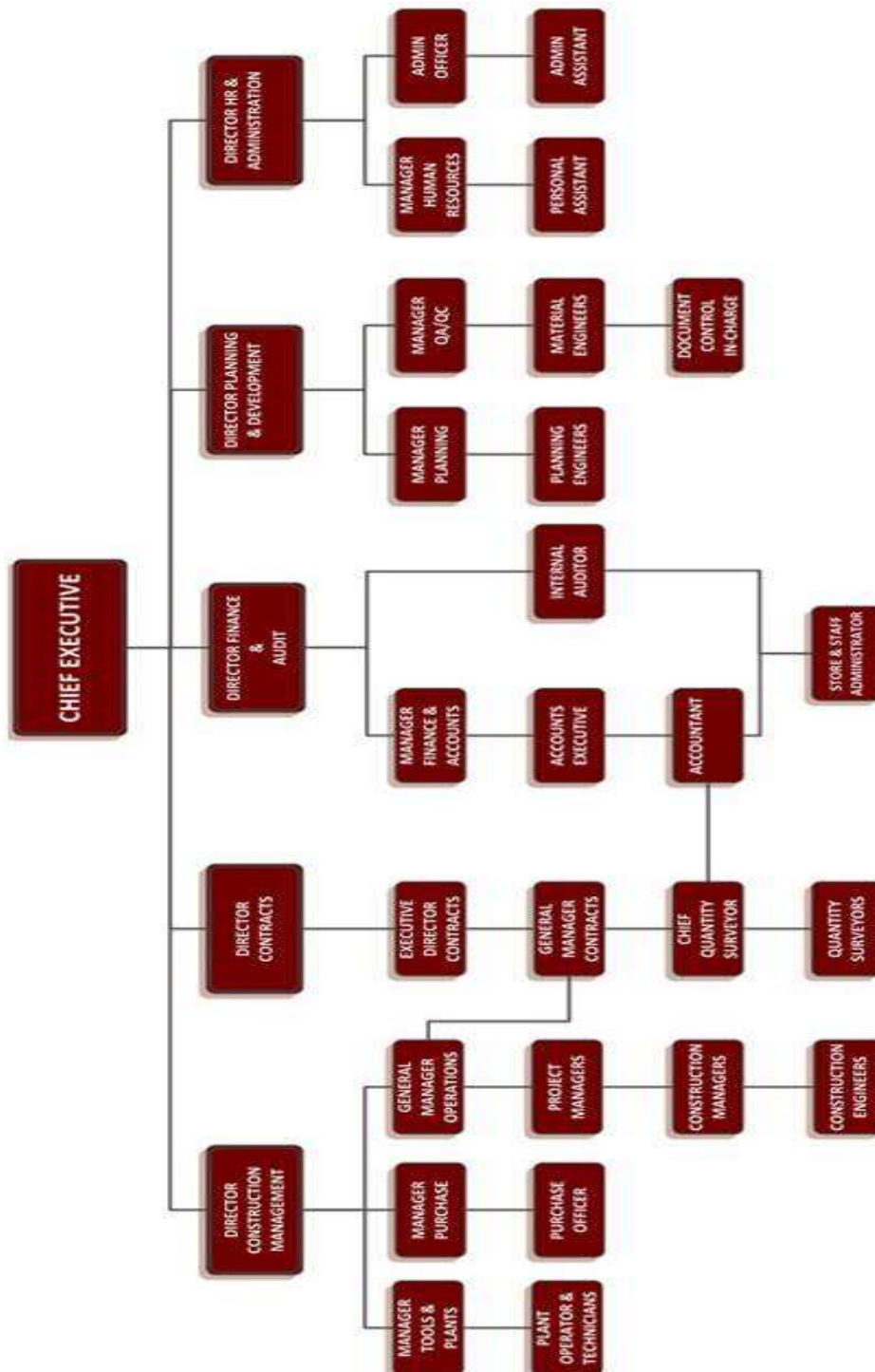

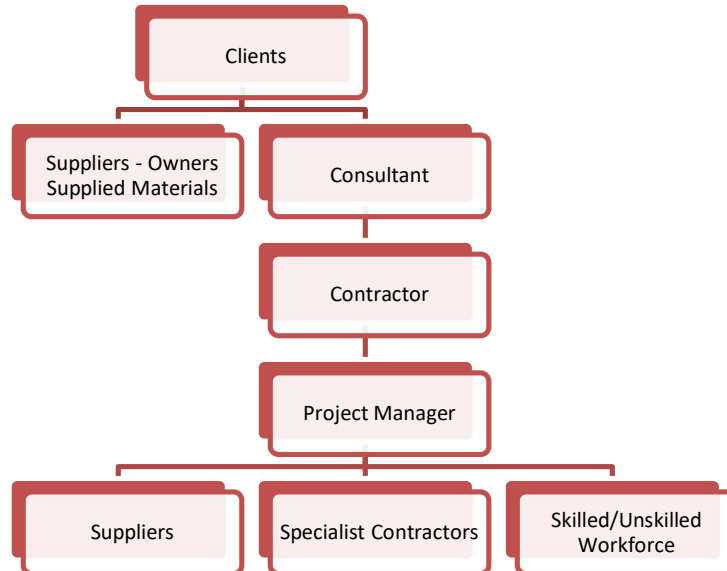

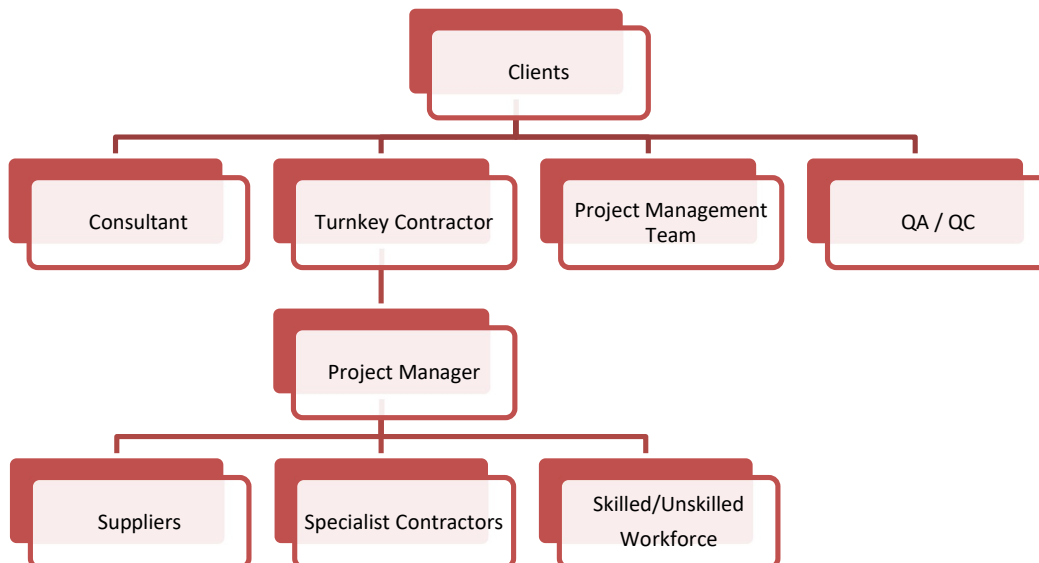

We are open to any established and recognized contractual arrangements, which may be suitable to our prospective clients. “Guaranteed maximum price” clause may be included in any type of the said contracts, such arrangement could be one of the following:

- **Unit Price Contract:** Detailed drawings, specifications and bills of quantities have to be developed prior to the contract agreement. The Unit Price contract is most suitable when the extent of variation in the quantities of work items is somewhat difficult to ascertain at the time of contract signing. Payments are made against running bills raised at periodic intervals. The running bills reflect the quantitative accomplishment of the BOQ items by the end of the pertinent period. The final bill is paid to the contractor, after successful completion of the project. Final settlement (release of retention etc.) is made after completion of maintenance period.
- **Lump-Sum Contract:** Wherever the project variables such as quantities, specs etc. are well established, Lump-sum type of contract becomes more feasible. The payments are made as the predetermined milestones are achieved. Final bill is released after completion of project. Final settlement is made after the completion of maintenance period.
- **Cost Plus Fixed Fee:** The cost plus fee is more suitable for project management and/or construction management services of the relatively smaller projects. The range of services may vary from turnkey concept to just construction management services. The fee is paid in installments at the achievement of predetermined stages of project.
- **Cost Plus Percentage:** The concept is suitable for project management and/or construction management services of relatively large projects. Again the range of services may vary from turnkey concepts to just construction management services. The payments are made against the bills raised by the contractor. The bill shows the proof of the actual costs incurred and the payment is made after applying the agreed percentage.

- **Cost Plus Fixed Fee + Incentive:** Incentive is offered by the client conditional to the pre-determined savings in the total cost of the project. Rests of the conditions are similar to a normal cost plus fixed fee contract.
- **Cost Plus Percentage + Incentive:** Again the incentive is offered by the client conditional to the achievement of the predetermined savings in the total cost of project as a result of contractor's efforts. Rests of the conditions are similar to the normal cost plus percentage type of contract.
